Update

Welcome to Issue 4 of the Greenbrae School Extension and Refurbishment newsletter. It has been a very busy few months and we are pleased to confirm that planning permission has been approved and we have a contractor appointed for the extension and refurbishment works.

The contractor has been confirmed as Robertson Construction. The official site handover is Monday 25th January. From next week, there will be some site preparation works taking place, mainly around the staff car park and towards the rear of the school.

During the construction period, parents of nursery children will be asked to drop off and collect their children from the rear nursery door, as the side door will be out of use during the construction works. The date is likely to be from the 1st of February, but we will confirm this with the Head Teacher.

There is a plan included within this newsletter detailing the new point of entrance for nursery pupils and parents. This will ensure the safety of children and parents as it keeps them as separate as possible from the construction site and traffic.

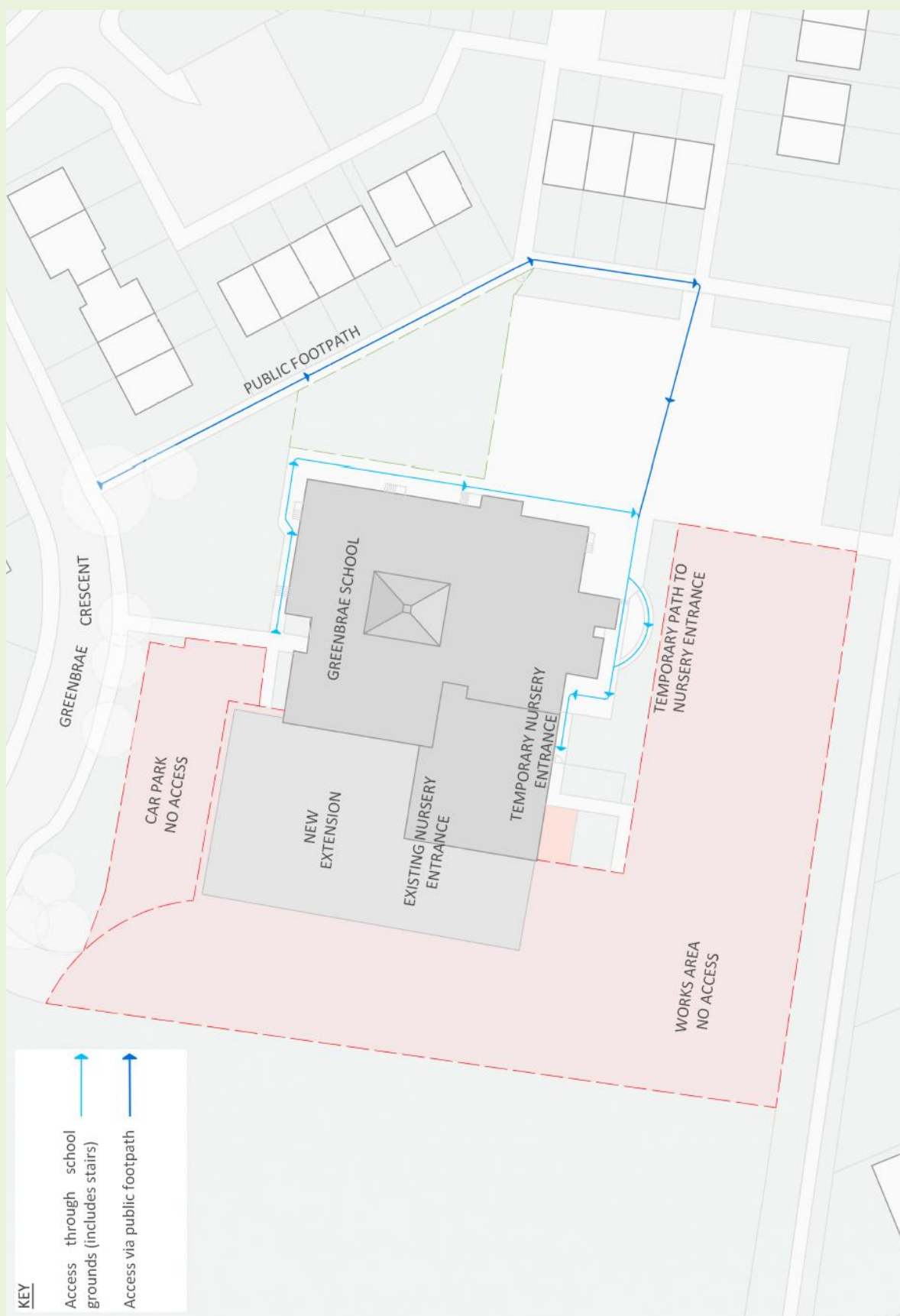
During the next week, the contractor's site will be fenced off and a new access road for the contractor's traffic will be in place. During the construction period, there will be a representative from Education & Children's Services Assets and Estates team based on site for a number of hours per week, along with the Council's Design Team.

Again, we will be working to ensure the swiftest possible build, without compromising on the quality of the finished product. We are committed to delivering the best learning environment possible for pupils at Greenbrae.

New Nursery Drop off Point

Our designers have prepared a plan for parents, indicating the new drop off point for nursery pupils. The new entrance point will be located at the rear of the nursery, and the new routes to get to this point are indicated in blue:

Now that the site has been handed over to the contractor, the area marked in red will be out of bounds for parents and pupils. We would stress that **no parents or carers are to access or use the staff car park** as there will be construction traffic using this area.

The safety of the pupils, staff, the public and the property throughout this project will remain paramount, and measures to ensure the highest standards of safety have been developed and will be continually reviewed.
