

Parent Council Meeting – AGM 31-08-2021 (Held via Google Meet)

Introductions were made and Mr Brian Carney was welcomed as the school representative for this year.

1 – Annual Report

Due to the pandemic the Parent Council has not been as active as in previous years, however, below are details of achievements for the past year:

- Continued as the link between parents / carers and school.
- Asked that the parent / carer group were surveyed regarding any permanent changes to the start and finish times of the school day hours.
- Participated in the School Improvement Plan.
- Advocated on behalf of the parent / carers regarding the use of the school as a polling station (to be followed up).
- Began discussions about possible crossing at the top of Greenbrae on Dubford Road (to be followed up).

2 – Voting of Roles

- 3 Treasurer Update

MS has already submitted this year's accounts. Current balance in PC account is £645.83 and we should be due to receive the next payment of £310 in the coming weeks. AR will discuss with staff regarding resources that could be bought, and a small sum will be retained in the account for the purpose of any training or workshops that the PC would look to provide to the wider parent and carers group that may incur a cost.

4 – Polling Station

SB noted that Eleanor Shepheard had discussed the use of schools as Polling Stations at the most recent Aberdeen Parent Council Forum Meeting but unfortunately she could not attend. The minutes of this meeting have not yet been distributed, SB will update AR and the PC members of the outcome of discussion asap. In the meantime, AR will get in touch with the Minister of the Baptist Church to confirm the church is still in agreement with being used as a venue for a Polling stating in the future.

5 – Curriculum Development

BC shared he is leading on the Vision, Vaues and Aims this year and is currently consulting with children and staff regarding the current school Vision, Values and Aims and to ensure they are still relevant and that previous goals identified are achievable. Mr Carney will share the ongoing work regarding the schools Vision, Values and Aims at the next PC meeting to be held on 05 October 2021.

5 - Head Teacher Update

AR shared the survey regarding changing of school hours has closed and whilst the outcome will be shared with parents and carers in the coming week (and there is a clear majority outcome) changes can not be made to the school day whilst bubbles remain necessary indoors. With increasing numbers of positive COVID cases in the community and in school the decision was made to maintain bubbles inside the school, with the children being able to mix in larger groups when outdoors.

Road Safety - AR shared she continues to receive information from people in the community that some children are not keeping safe whilst riding bikes to school. Children have been seen to not stop at kerb and cycle straight on to the road / zebra crossing. Road Safety is a planned topic for upcoming assembly the school have also received reflectors and high vis armbands for each child and they will be encouraged to use these, particularly as the mornings and becoming darker. KO will also post on the PC Facebook page a reminder for parents and carers collecting children from school to be mindful of the increasing number of children trying to stay on the pavement whilst riding their bikes.

School Football – MS asked whether school football was being allowed to start back up. AR was unsure as it may be the parameters around this have changed however, she is meeting with the newly appointed active school's coordinator and will discuss with him and feedback.
