

WHAT HAPPENS AT NYCOS REGIONAL CHOIR REHEARSALS?

In the first two years the choir meets for an hour (increasing in the third year as the children progress) every week during term time.

Rehearsal time is split between small groups taking part in fun games designed to help choir members develop their singing and musical skills, and full singing sessions learning a wide variety of songs to perform. At the end of the winter and summer terms there are concerts for family and friends, where choir members showcase all they have learned. Throughout the year, the choir may also have the opportunity to perform at various external events.

NYCOS MUSICIANSHIP AWARDS

NYCOS has developed an award programme to chart the progress of choir members, give them goals to work towards and provide a sense of achievement. Split into three levels. Bronze, Silver and Gold - members are informally tested on pitching, sound production, solo singing and simple theory on completion of each stage, and award badges are presented. A Gold level pass can be used as a substitute ABRSM Grade V Theory.

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE RECRUITMENT WORKSHOP?

In small groups of 15 - 20 our staff will be able to assess whether your child is ready to join the choir by playing singing games. It's fun and engaging for the children! If there is enough room in the venue, parents can watch the session and see how it's done. Once the session is over, we will write to you and let you know the outcome.
